Anatomy of the Solar Roof

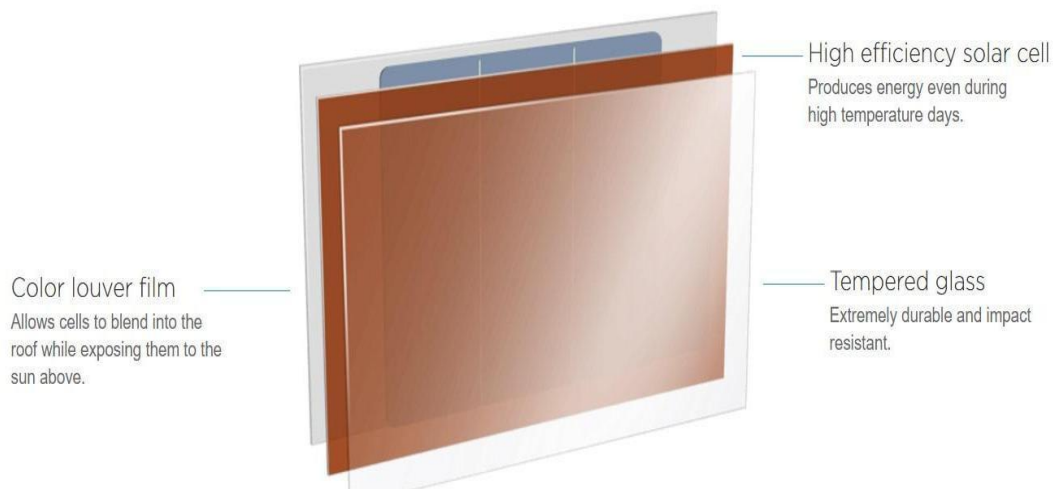
